
Case

61 y/o male

Indigestion at lunch then collapses. He has high quality bystander CPR immediately with AED and defibrillation within 5mins. He is transported via Paramedics intubated. He receives 4 shocks en route without sustained ROSC and has had 300mg Amiodarone. This is his initial ECG.



What rhythm is he in?

Outline 8 justifications for your rhythm choice.

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He has been having CPR for 30 minutes without sustained ROSC. Outside of the standard ACLS protocol give 3 interventions which may improve his chance of survival.

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
