

The Sutherland Hospital Emergency Department

Orthopaedic Patients - Information Sheet

Orthopaedic specialists working at Sutherland Hospital see patients in their private rooms. This allows you to make an appointment rather than waiting for long periods on a first-come first-serve hospital clinic. There will be a payment required on the day of your appointment and the Medicare rebate may not meet all charges even if you are a pension card holder. Each specialist has a different fee structure and you should ask about this when you make an appointment. If you are worried about the cost of this referral, please see your GP as many fractures can be managed without specialist referral.

- Please take the letter given to you by the emergency department doctor to the specialist appointment.
- If you had an x-ray while in the emergency department, you will need to bring this to the consultation. A copy of your x-ray can be obtained from the Radiology Department. (You should ring them first 9540 7644 to allow time to prepare a copy).
- You may seek a referral from your local doctor (GP) to the rooms of any Orthopaedic Surgeon of your choice.
